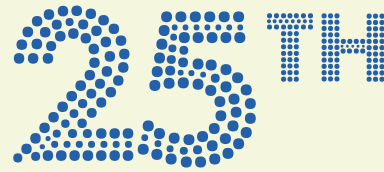

HOME DEFENDERS LEAGUE

The Home Defenders League are a leading grassroots voice to prevent the wave of foreclosures devastating California. Alliance of Californians for Community Empowerment members launched the Home Defenders League last year and called on homeowners across California to stay in their homes. They are an outstanding voice organizing for affordable, permanent loan modifications.

SAN DIEGO CITY COUNCIL

The City Council passed a strong resolution advocating that the California Legislature cap interest rates charged by payday lenders at 36% APR. The entire City Council under the leadership of Councilmember Todd Gloria worked with local community groups pass the resolution despite intense industry opposition. Hopefully, the City Council's resolution will become a model for other cities.

SHIRLEY HOCHHAUSEN

Shirley Hochhausen is a champion of justice and a sworn enemy of predatory lending and economic exploitation. Shirley has worked effectively, imaginatively, and tirelessly for years to advance strategies to increase the rights of low income borrowers. Shirley has trained and inspired a generation of new lawyers to combat predatory lending practices through litigation, legislation and creative advocacy.

TENANTS TOGETHER

Tenants Together responded early and strongly on behalf of tenants being evicted in the foreclosure crisis. They brought the plight of tenants in foreclosed properties to the forefront. As a result, tenants around the state receive assistance and information ensuring protection against illegal behavior by banks. They have placed tenants on the legislative agenda and effectively advocated for crucial protections.
